If you want to change your Windows user account settings in Vista or Win7, you don't need to go all the way to the Control Panel's User Accounts utility to do it. Instead, you can bring up the same window by clicking the Start button and then clicking your account picture at the top of the Start menu.

From here, you'll be able to change your account name, type, picture, or password and modify settings for other user accounts.

(NOTE: Clicking the account picture in Windows XP will let you change the picture but not the other account settings. You will need to go to Start, then Control Panel, then User Accounts to make the other changes.)
