

RESTORE ALT-KEY SHORTCUTS

You may have noticed in Windows XP (including Outlook Express and Internet Explorer, but not MS Office) that the underlined letters in menus are missing. The Active Keys feature in previous versions of Windows enabled you to press the ALT key together with the underlined letter to activate a menu item. If you like this feature, you can restore these shortcuts by:

1. Right-clicking your Desktop.
2. Selecting Properties, the Appearance tab, the Effects button.
3. Removing the check mark from "Hide Underlined Letters For Keyboard Navigation Until I Press The ALT Key."
