

# BAZOOKA ADWARE AND SPYWARE SCANNER

Spyware and Adware are software that is installed on a computer without the user's knowledge which gathers information about that user for later retrieval by whoever controls the spyware.

Generally, "adware" can be considered a form of spyware; however it typically monitors you for only one purpose—to deliver targeted ads. Spyware is typically seen as a surveillance tool that an unknown and uninvited party uses to obtain information from your PC, from recording every keystroke you make on a keyboard to scanning your computer for credit card numbers.

Some spyware may be considered harmless, but because these programs communicate information back to another computer via the Internet, they provide opportunities for hackers looking for an easy way into a computer. Hackers can exploit security flaws in the spyware itself and access your system to run programs, upload or download data, or possibly take control of your PC.

Most experts suggest the more anti spyware programs you have installed, the better. Many programs detect spyware and adware. However, **Bazooka Adware and Spyware Scanner** not only detects unwelcome guests, it obliterates them. This program detects spyware, adware, Trojan horses, key loggers, various trackware components and more-stuff that many antivirus software programs overlook. Once Bazooka detects something, it gives you easy-to-follow, step-by-step instructions for uninstalling the threat. Bazooka Spyware Scanner searches for more than 500 threats, including ghost programs that track your surfing habits, which can lead to even more pop-up windows.
