

BURN CDs WITH WINDOWS XP APPLET

Burning CDs can be a source of frustration for many beginners, but if you use Windows XP or Vista, you have an integrated primitive-but-usable CD-burner.

To use this feature, right-click a target file or folder. From the context menu that appears, select Send To, then your CD/DVD drive. Repeat these steps for each file you want to burn (copy) to CD. This will place a copy of each item in a separate holding area. When you are ready to burn the files, insert your CD, then go to My Computer, right-click your CD drive, and select Write These files to CD. That's all there is to it. Sit back and let the process do its thing.
