Is your cursor a little too slender to see without squinting? A Control Panel setting will provide the necessary change.

For **Windows XP**:

Take this route: **Start>Control Panel>Accessibility Options**. Choose the **Display Tab** and then under **Cursor Options** you can set your width.

For **Windows Vista**:

Take this route: **Start>Control Panel>Ease of Access Center>Make the Computer Easier to See**

Towards the bottom you'll see an option to set the thickness of the blinking cursor. Set it to the desired width.
